8. Facts of Case:

This case relates to commission of Dacoity and Looting by the terrorists of Khalistan Commando Force on 12.02.1987 from Punjab National

Bank, Ludhiana. An FIR No. 26/87 was registered at PS Div. No. 6, Ludhiana, Punjab with respect to the above said crime. Later on, the investigation of this case was entrusted to the CBI by the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pension, Deptt. of Personnel and Training, Govt. of India and accordingly, Case RC.1(S)/1987 was registered in CBI.

The allegation in brief is that PO Sarjinder Singh, S/o Master Avtar Singh, Village Rupawal, PS Garhdiwala, Hoshiarpur, Punjab; conspired with other co-accused persons and facilitated the dacoity in the aforesaid bank. He had looted the DCM Toyota vehicle alongwith other accused persons from one Pyare Lal and later on the said vehicle was used in the dacoity. After completion of investigation, a Chargesheet dated 14.07.1988 was filed before the competent Court against accused Sarjinder Singh and others.

The accused has been declared Proclaimed Offender (PO) by the Court of Law vide order its dated 30.03.1992. A Look Out Circular (LOC) No. 1840655 with validity till 01.02.2019, has been issued against the accused.
